COURSE OBJECTIVES

To enable delegates to conduct effective OHS internal audits and evaluate legal compliance.

BENEFITS

Delegates will be given a thorough introduction to the principles of health and safety management, continual improvement and the requirements of current legislation. The OHSAS 18001 approach to OHAS management is interpreted in detail. Procedures for hazard identification, risk assessment, emergency planning, training, communication, consultation, accident reporting and management review are discussed and defined.

Using the OHSAS 18001 model, delegates will be able to define roles and responsibilities of auditors and plan, co-ordinate and perform OHSAS audits. Moreover, they will be able to collect, analyse and report upon the findings and evidence of OHSAS audits and present them to management for review.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

Anyone who holds responsibilities and liabilities for occupational health and safety management and potential OHS Internal Auditors. It will also be very useful for consultants advising on the implementation of OHSAS systems including OHSAS 18001. Prior knowledge of Health & Safety legislation or Management Systems is an advantage.
